
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

Service

Outreach to those in need is at the heart of summer ministry. We work with Chicago’s inner-city youth and do migrant ministry and day camps in Fresno, CA.

Through the activities and time shared with children, families, and the elderly, the Claretians and summer volunteers strive to help others grow in their sense of self-worth, and experience joy and hope for the future.

Community

Summer volunteers support each other in their ministries by working together as a staff and by living together in community. They share together common prayer and daily household tasks, with time to take in local attractions.
